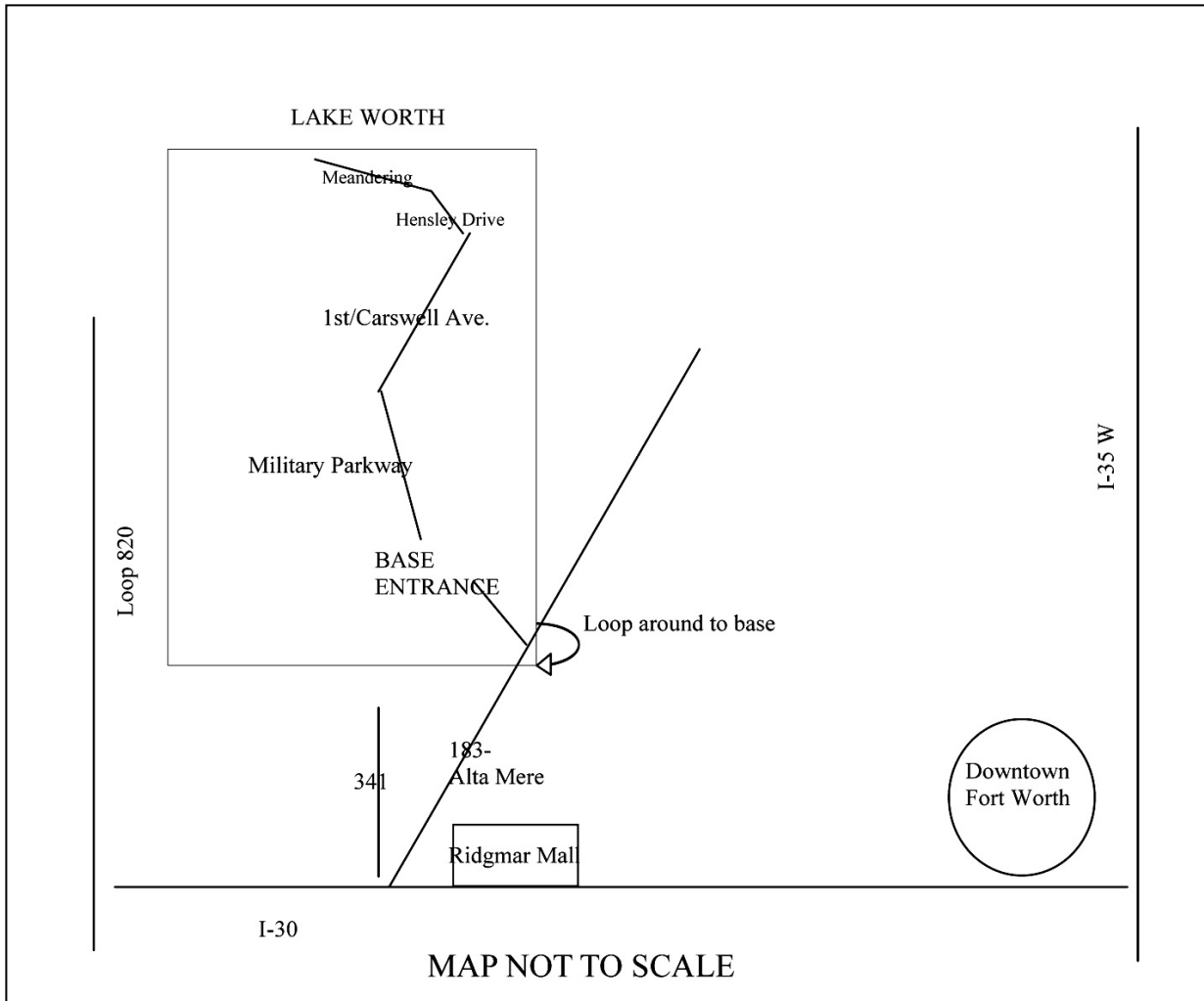

**Coming from Loop 820 West take Ex. #3B onto I-30 East. Proceed on I-30 and take Ex.7A onto 183/ Alta Mere North.**

Proceed north on 183 to just past the **QT** (on your right) - get into the right lane and take the right loop onto the base road. Continue to Main Gate. **(NASJRB sign).**

Once inside Main Gate continue on Military Pky. to Carswell Ave. turn right & follow signs to start.

**Going South on I-35W take Ex.# 51 onto I-30 West - Going North take Ex.# 51A, West.**

Proceed West on I-30 to **Ex. # 7B 183/Alta Mere North.** Proceed north on 183 to just past the **QT** (on your right) and take the right loop onto the base road. Continue to Main Gate. **(NASJRB sign).**

Once inside Main Gate continue on Military Pky., to Carswell Ave. turn right & follow signs to start. **From East on I-30 continue to Ex.#7B** and follow directions above.

## Regulations for the Event

September 25, 2010

Due to the fact this event is open to the public we are required to list the following regulations.

1. Photo ID is required for all participants 12 years and older. No exceptions.
2. The main gate will open to walkers at 8:30AM, not before.
3. All bags will be checked. The only items allowed are children necessity items (i.e. diaper bags, milk bottles, strollers are authorized).
4. All pets are prohibited except for guide dogs for the blind and disabled.
5. Weapons, firearms, (regardless of whether you are a permit holder), including knives, guns and blunt objects. Any weapons brought on base will be confiscated and the owner will be asked to leave the Naval Air Station. Confiscated items will not be returned. All alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia, medications not belonging to the individual, glass containers and pyrotechnics of any kind, flammable liquids of any kind are prohibited.
6. Speed limits on base are strictly adhered to.
