ELIGIBILITY: The walks are open to the public and everyone is welcome. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Walk, jog, run, or bike at your own pace. All participants will sign a waiver of responsibility and must carry a start card. This event is normally held regardless of weather conditions.

PETS: Pets are welcome and must be kept leashed at all times. Pets are not allowed in any public buildings [with the exception of service animals].

DATES: 2-4 March 2018

Friday walk: **Big Springs Ranch for Children**, [Real Co.] 10664 US-83, Leakey, TX 78873. Ranch is 13 miles north of Leakey, TX on US-83. Additionally, the ranch can be reached from IH-10 NW of Kerrville by exiting on TX-41 west (only direction possible) for 24 miles, then left (south) on US-83 for 14 miles. The start area will be on the WEST side of the highway and will be marked.

Start time: **1:00-5:00** **Finish time:** **7:00**

Saturday walk & bike: **Sul Ross State Univ. – Rio Grande College**, [Val Verde Co.] 205 Wildcat Dr. (Bldg M), Del Rio, TX 78840. From Veterans Blvd (US-90), turn west on Cantu Rd (by the Chevron/Stripes). Drive one mile on Cantu Rd. Turn left (south) on Wildcat Dr. Completely pass SRSU-RGC/SWTJC on the right (Del Rio HS on left). Turn into last parking lot and continue around right into the back lots. Enter the back of Building M.

Start time: **8:00-12:00** **Finish time:** **3:00**

Sunday walk **Kickapoo Cavern State Park**, [Edwards & Kinney Cos.] 20939 RM 674, Brackettville, TX 78832. KCSP is located 23 miles north of Brackettville on RM-674, a windy, scenic highway climbing into the Hill Country - allow extra time to drive. From Del Rio, take US-90 30 miles east to Brackettville, then turn left (north) on RM-674 at the only traffic light on US-90 by the Stripes. KCSP will be on the left (west) side of the road.

Start time: **9:00-12:00** **Finish time:** **3:00**

RESTROOMS/WATER: Water and restrooms will be available at the start points. Walkers and cyclists are reminded and encouraged to bring plenty of water with them, especially during the ten months of South Texas summer (which sometimes includes March).

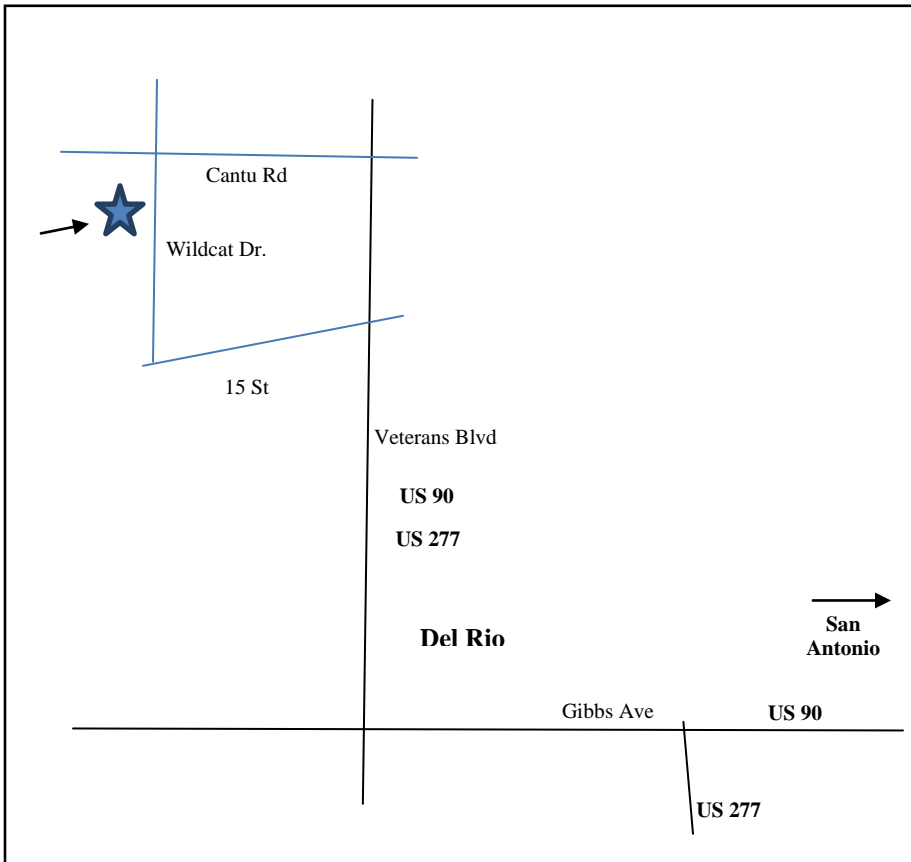
